NOTIFICATION

*Islamabad, the 9th May, 2019*

**S. R. O. 547(I)/2019.**—In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of rule 3 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973 and section 7 (1) (b) (i) and (ii) of Federal Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1977 (XLV of 1977), the following method, qualifications and other conditions are laid down for appointment to the post, specified in the Table below, in the Office of the Attorney General for Pakistan:—

### METHOD OF APPOINTMENT

2. The method of appointment to the post shall be as under:—

Provided that if no suitable person is available for initial appointment, the post or posts reserved for initial appointment shall be filled in by transfer, in terms of Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1973.

### QUALIFICATION, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR INITIAL APPOINTMENT

3. A candidate for initial appointment must possess the educational qualifications and experiences and must be within the age limits as mentioned against the posts concerned in the Schedule to this Notification, provided that —

- (i) “experience” means post-qualification experience gained in a regular full-time paid job after obtaining the required qualifications;
- (ii) the period spent by a candidate in obtaining degree of M. Phil or Ph.D in the relevant field shall be treated as practical experience up to a maximum period of two and four years respectively for the purpose of initial appointment, provided that —
  - (a) a candidate who has obtained the degree of M. Phil or Ph.D. during service shall not be entitled to a double benefit of counting the said period as service towards experience prescribed for the post; and
  - (b) this concession shall not be available for the posts for which the prescribed qualification is M.Phil or Ph.D.
- (iii) the maximum age-limit shall be relaxed in respect of the candidates specified and to the extent indicated in the Initial Appointment to Civil Posts (Relaxation of Upper Age Limit) Rules, 1993 as amended from time to time; and
- (iv) eligibility of candidates shall be reckoned on the closing date fixed for submission of applications for initial appointment to the post concerned and the instructions issued by the Federal Government and the Federal Public Service Commission from time to time.



**APPOINTMENT BY TRANSFER**

4. Appointment by transfer shall be made by selection from amongst the persons holding appointment on regular basis under the Federal Government in the same basic pay scale in which the post to be filled exists, provided that the person concerned possesses the qualifications and experience prescribed for initial appointment to the post concerned.

**PROBATION**

5. Persons appointed by initial appointment or promotion or transfer shall be on probation subject to the provisions of the Civil Servants Act, 1973 and rules made thereunder.

6. This Notification issues with the concurrence of the Establishment Division's *vide* its O.M. No.7/15/96-R-6 dated 22-03-2019 and Federal Public Service Commission *vide* its letter No. 12-14/2019-RR, dated 07-05-2019.
