3. Qualification, Experience and age limit for initial appointment.

A condition for initial appointment shall be a citizen of PakiStan possess the educational qualifications and experience, and be within the age limit, mentioned in the schedule to this notification:

Provided that the age limit is relaxable in case of Government servants:

Provided further that the maximum age limit shall relaxable by 3 years in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Bhudhist Community, recognised tribes of the Tribal Areas, Azad Kashmir, and Northern Areas (District of Gilgit, Ghizer, Skardu and Gamche and Diamir) in accordance with the instructions issued by the Establishment Division, from time to time.

- Probation. Persons appointed by initial appointment, promotion or transfer shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded, or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be specified at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of section 6 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973 (LXXI of 1973).
